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## About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, the City of Paducah conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in May 2018 and data were collected through June 20, 2018. After the official data collection period was underway (see the report, The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Paducah, $K Y$, 2018), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during June 2018 and 143 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey that have not been weighted to current population estimates of Paducah.

## Complete Survey Responses

The following pages contain a complete set of responses to each question on the survey, excluding the "don't know" responses. The percent of respondents giving a particular response is shown followed by the number of respondents (denoted with " $\mathrm{N}=$ ").
