Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

2016



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Summary

The National Citizen Survey[™] (The NCS[™]) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency, household income, race/ethnicity and age.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (370 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Where differences were noted, residents who had a household income in excess of \$100,000 or who had lived in Paducah for five years or less were more likely to give positive ratings to aspects within the pillar of Community Characteristics than their counterparts. More specifically, residents who were aged 55 or greater, who made \$100,000 or more annually or who were white were more likely to give positive ratings to their neighborhoods as places to live than residents who were younger, made less money annually or who were Hispanic or other race. Residents who lived in Paducah between six and 20 years tended to rate aspects of Mobility less favorably than those who had lived in the city for fewer or more years.
- Patterns of differences among demographic groups within the pillar of Governance were similar; residents who had lived in Paducah for five years or less, who had an annual household income greater than \$100,000 annually or who were white were more likely to favorably rate these aspects. Several exceptions to this pattern, however, did exist. For example, the rating for the value of services for taxes paid was most favorably rated by residents whose income was between \$50,000 and \$99,999. Additionally, ratings for bus or transit services were higher among the Hispanic and/or another race group compared to ratings among white residents.
- Within the pillar of Participation, ratings among demographic groups varied. Where differences were significant, residents who had an annual household income between \$25,000 and \$49,999 or who were between the ages of 18-34 were less likely to say they planned to remain in Paducah for the next five years. With respect to aspects of Mobility, residents who had lived in Paducah between six and 20 years or who were younger than 54 were more likely to have reported they walked or biked instead of driving and carpooled than those with a shorter or longer tenure in the city or who were older. Meanwhile, residents who had lived in the city for longer than 6 years, who were between the ages of 35 and 54 years old or who were Hispanic and/or other race were more likely to say they were under housing cost stress than their counterparts.
- When asked about priorities for the community, younger residents (those between the ages of 18-34) were more likely to place a higher importance on the quality of the overall natural environment in Paducah, overall opportunities for education and enrichment and the overall economic health of the city than their older counterparts.
- As it related to recycling, residents with a shorter tenure in the city (five years or less), who made more than \$50,000 annually or who were between the ages of 18-34 were more likely to support the implementation of the program than those in the other demographic groups. Additionally, residents who had lived in the City for five years or less and who were between the ages of 18 and 34 stated they had contact with an employee of the Paducah Police Department more frequently than those who had a longer tenure or who were older.
