**Suspect:** White male, 5-feet-8 and 150 pounds, mid- to late-20s, with heavy beard stubble, wearing a dark navy hoody with white or faded gray lettering on the front and dark jeans

Paducah police are investigating the robbery Thursday evening of the Lourdes Hospital gift shop.

A hospital volunteer working in the gift shop reported a white male, described above, entered the gift shop and put a note on the counter demanding money. The robber claimed to have a gun, but did not display one. The volunteer gave the robber cash, and he fled.
