



Mayor Gayle Kaler's 2016 Student Christmas Ornament Contest

*Mayor Gayle Kaler wants to fill a Christmas tree in City Hall
with ornaments handcrafted by students.
All ornaments meeting the criteria will be displayed.
The top ornaments out of each category will be recognized.*

To: All students in K-12th grades who reside in either Paducah or outside the city limits in McCracken County.

Judging Categories: Grades K-3rd; Grades 4th-8th; and Grades 9th-12th

Criteria:

- Ornaments should be 3-7 inches in height (not including hanger) and ready to hang.
- Ornaments should be approximately a half pound or less in weight.
- No glass or other breakable materials.
- Only one entry per student.
- The use of recycled and natural materials is encouraged.
- Special consideration will be given to ornaments that feature Paducah's history, landmarks, name, etc.
- Enclose a completed Ornament Submission Form with your entry providing a detailed description of the ornament. Ornaments that cannot be matched with the Ornament Submission Form may be displayed but will not be eligible for judging.
- Artwork must be the student's own.
- Ornaments will be viewed close up so details are important.

Entry Fee: No entry fee is required.

Submission Deadline: Entry with Ornament Submission Form must be delivered to the Mayor's Office at Paducah City Hall, 300 South 5th Street, by Tuesday, November 29, 2016 at 4:30 p.m. Schools can collect entries with forms and contact Public Information Officer Pam Spencer (270-444-8669 or pspencer@paducahky.gov) to make arrangements for her to pick up the entries.

Recognition: The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each category will be recognized at a City Commission Meeting at 5:30 p.m. on December 6, 2016 at City Hall.
