## BURIAL FEES - CREMAINS

City of Paducah Parks Department does the openings/closings on **Cremains**. If the services are during a regular workday, the charge is **\$175.00**. If it is on the weekend or after hours, the charge is **\$225.00**. We do not provide tent & chairs for the service but we can place the grassy carpet down if the Family or Funeral Home requests it.

## BURIAL LOT FEES

**Baby Graves** - these graves are 1/2 the size of an adult grave space so therefore they are less expensive. We have baby graves available in the following sections:

Rushing Additions Section 6 & 9. Price - **\$200.00**  
Old Additions. Price - **\$200.00**

**Adult Graves** - we have adult graves available in the following sections:

Rushing Addition Section 9. Price - **\$400.00 (Flat Stones Only)**  
Old Additions. Price - **\$300.00**  
Mausoleum Additions. Price - **\$500.00**

These spaces are held for honorable members.
