


## Oak Grove Cemetery Maps

Oak Grove Cemetery has had its burial records available on the web for several years. These records are available to the public in the form of Excel spreadsheets and can be accessed by visiting the City of Paducah's web site [www.paducahky.gov](http://www.paducahky.gov) and clicking on the Oak Grove Cemetery link.

The City's Information Technology Department has utilized its GIS resources to combine the burial records with a cemetery map forming an interactive map. Access to this online historical resource is available by clicking on the Maps (MAP-GIS) link on the City's Home page or directly at <http://map-gis.org>



In this example, a **search** was made only on the Last Name of Smith. No First Name or Maiden Name was entered. Notice when zoomed in the cemetery lots are automatically labeled with the Addition, Section and Lot data.

Please note, the Cemetery is divided into four Additions (Old, New, Mausoleum, and Rushing). Each Addition is divided into Sections. Each Section is divided into Lots. Each Lot is divided into Graves. The location of each burial is currently only accurate to the Lot level. Therefore, the dots representing the grave locations may not be in their exact location. However, the burial location on the map should be within a few feet of the actual grave.
